**TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4-192(b)(25) OF THE BLACK
HAWK MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING OCCUPATIONAL TAXES
FOR LIQUOR-LICENSED ESTABLISHMENTS**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BLACK HAWK, GILPIN COUNTY:

Section 1. Section 4-192(b)(25) the City of Black Hawk Municipal Code is amended
to read as follows:

Sec. 4–192. Occupational Taxes.

* * *

(b) The following businesses, professions, and occupations shall
pay an annual occupational tax as follows:

* * *

(25) Liquor license:

 a. All liquor licensed establishments licensed within
the meaning of Article 3 of Title 44, as the same may be amended
from time to time, located within gaming establishments or located
within any gaming district of the City shall pay the amount of seven
hundred dollars (\$700.00); and

 b. All liquor licensed establishments licensed within
the meaning of Article 3 of Title 44, as the same may be amended
from time to time, located outside of the gaming district of the City
shall pay the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

Section 2. Safety Clause. The City Council hereby finds, determines, and declares that
this Ordinance is promulgated under the general police power of the City of Black Hawk, that it is
promulgated for the health, safety, and welfare of the public, and that this Ordinance is necessary
for the preservation of health and safety and for the protection of public convenience and welfare.
The City Council further determines that the Ordinance bears a rational relation to the proper
legislative object sought to be attained.


Section 3. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, or part of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction invalid, such judgment shall not affect application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 4. Effective Date. The City Clerk is directed to post the Ordinance as required by the Charter. This Ordinance shall become effective upon posting by the City Clerk.
